## International Students Financial Information Form

Federal Immigration Law, as specified in the Immigration Act of 1990, requires that all international students seeking admittance into US institutions of higher education to submit information detailing the financial resources that will be available to them during their first academic year (8 months or 2 Trimesters). Such resources must be adequate to pay for all necessary expenses including tuition, fees, books, and normal living costs. Please note that anyone can be a financial sponsor, or the student can sponsor himself or herself if financially capable of doing so. The current amount needed to meet expenses for the first academic year is \$37,590. Students must show proof of adequate health insurance at the beginning of each Trimester before being allowed to register. **This amount is subject to change; please check with the International Advisor for the current amount before submission of this form.**

In order to insure compliance with this law, international students are required to complete the form below and submit it to the Admissions Office of Parker College. Please note that Parker College operates on a Trimester system, and is in session for 3 Trimesters per year. *Every international student must be sure that there are enough funds for the entire year, although the documentation for Immigration purposes is only required for two Trimesters. Do not assume that the monies available for the 8-month academic year will be enough to cover expenses for the entire 12-month period.*

**Parker College of Chiropractic cannot grant admission or issue an I-20 Student Visa Eligibility Form to any international student until all financial and sponsorship information has been received by the International Advisor and the student has met all admissions requirements.**

Federal Immigration Law, as specified by the Immigration Act of 1990, requires all international students seeking admission into US institutions of higher education to provide additional documentation of financial accountability for each dependent who will accompany the student to the US. The following amounts for dependents will be added to the required \$37,590 base figure:

- For one (1) dependent, an additional \$5,500 US will be required.
- For two (2) dependents, an additional \$8,000 US will be required.
- For three (3) dependents, an additional \$10,100 US will be required.
- For four (4) dependents, an additional \$12,000 US will be required.
